Food Sales: Sale of food in any form must be pre-approved by the MN Dept of Agriculture. For more details, visit their website at <https://www.mda.state.mn.us/retail-mobile-food-handler>

Park Usage: Any sale located in city parks must be pre-approved by the City of Burnsville. For more details visit their website at <https://www.burnsvillemn.gov/1477/Vending-in-Parks-Permit>

Maps: The map will be available online through the Facebook page and paper maps will be delivered to participating sale holders the evening before the sale. If enough funds exist, additional paper maps will also be available at local businesses.

Parking Restrictions: The Burnsville Police Department requires that parking is limited to one side of each street (except River Hills Drive) to ensure access for emergency vehicles. Please keep your own vehicles off the street and politely enforce the “one side only” parking rule in your area by posting the signs given to each sale when maps are distributed. Signs will be picked up within one week, thank you for your patience.

Trash: Please provide a bin for trash disposal to prevent littering. All food sites MUST provide trash bins.

Post-Sale Donations: A donation of 5% from each sale's profits is requested to help a deserving organization. Envelopes and Venmo donation methods will be provided to each sale site.
